- The Commission has published its proposal for a €100 billion research and innovation programme in the next EU long-term EU budget 2021–2027. Horizon Europe- the new programme which will succeed Horizon 2020 - will be the biggest ever research and innovation funding programme.

- Guidance on the impact of Brexit on the regulated professions and recognition of qualifications has been published by the Commission. Decisions taken before the withdrawal date will not be affected but after that date recognition will be governed by the policies and rules of each of the EU-27 Member States.

- The Fifth Anti-Money Laundering Directive will enter into force on 9 July 2018. EU Member States will then have 18 months to implement the Fifth AML Directive into national law (10 January 2020 deadline).
